- In the event of the death of the purchaser the local authority may before permitting any burial in the above-mentioned plot, require satisfactory evidence of the right to ownership, and of the right of any deceased person to be buried in such plot.
- Any sale of an exclusive right may at any time be rescinded by agreement between the local authority and the person for the time being appearing to be entitled as owner to such exclusive right. The local authority may pay to such person such price as may be agreed in consideration of such rescission for which the receipt of such person shall be sufficient discharge.
- This agreement is made subject to the provisions of the bylaws relating to cemeteries made by the local authority. Notwithstanding this agreement shall lapse if, **60 years pass without a burial taking place** in that part of the cemetery or in that vault, brick grave, or place of burial which is the subject of such exclusive right.
