SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF 2009/2019 LONG TERM COUNCIL COMMUNITY PLAN

1.0 SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to present the finalised 2009/2019 Long Term Council Plan (LTCCP) for final adoption. A copy of the final 2009/2019 LTCCP is attached.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

THAT

Council adopt the final Central Hawke's Bay District Council LTCCP 2009/2019 as amended.

REASON

Council is required to adopt the updated 2009/19 before 1 July 2009 pursuant to Section 93 of the Local Government Act 2002.

3.0 BACKGROUND

The 2009/2019 Long Term Council Community Plan is the third Plan to be prepared in the Long Term Council Community Plan environment.

Minor amendments have been made to the LTCCP as a result of submissions received by Council following the special consultative procedures and heard by Council at the submission hearings held on 28th May 2009. The updated LTCCP has been reviewed by our Auditors, whose report is included.

4.0 OPTION

That Council adopt the final Central Hawke's Bay District Council LTCCP 2009/2019 as amended.

5.0 STATUTORY IMPLICATIONS

Once adopted, Council must make the LTCCP publicly available within one month from the date of adoption and send copies to the Secretary of Local Government, the Auditor General and the Parliamentary Library.

6.0 CONSULTATION

6.1 External

The LTCCP is being adopted using the special consultative procedure laid down in the Local Government Act 2002. A two day Information Expo was held and a total of 61 submissions were received from the public, government agencies and other organisations. Submissions were heard by Council on 28 May 2009.
