SUBJECT: FEES AND CHARGES 2009/2010

1.0 SUMMARY

Council is required under Section 103 of the Local Government Act 2002, to give notice of its intentions to raise fees and charges payable for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010.

The draft schedule of fees and charges has been included in the special consultative process followed for the Council's Long Term Council Community Plan (LTCCP) 2009/19.

A copy of the proposed fees and charges is included in the LTCCP document.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

THAT

1. The 2009/2010 Fees and Charges Schedule is adopted.
2. That Council give notice pursuant to Section 103 of the Local Government Act 2002 of its intention to prescribe the fees payable for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010 in respect of certificates, authorities, approvals, consents, and services given or inspections made by the Council under the Local Government Act 2002, the Building Act 2004, the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, the Dog Control Act 1996, Impounding Act 1955, the Resource Management Act 1991, Health (Registration of Premises) Regulations 1966 and the Central Hawke's Bay District Council Bylaws as set out in the Fees and Charges Schedule 2009/2010.

3.0 BACKGROUND

The fees and charges noted in the schedule for 2009/2010 relate to certificates, approvals, consents, and services given or inspections made by the Council under the Local Government Act 2002, the Building Act 2004, the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, the Dog Control Act 1996, Impounding Act 1955, the Resource Management Act 1991, Health (Registration of Premises) Regulations 1966 and the Central Hawkes Bay District Council By Laws as set out in the Schedule of Fees and Charges for 2009/2010.

4.0 OPTION

1. That the 2009/2010 Fees and Charges Schedule is adopted.
2. That Council give notice pursuant to Section 103 of the Local Government Act 2002 of its intention to prescribe the fees payable for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010 in respect of certificates, authorities, approvals, consents, and services given or inspections made by the Council under the Local Government Act 2002, the Building Act 2004, the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, the Dog Control Act 1996, Impounding Act 1955, the Resource Management Act 1991, Health (Registration of Premises) Regulations 1966 and the Central Hawke's Bay District Council Bylaws as set out in the Fees and Charges Schedule 2009/2010.
