

# ***Amendments to Council's Long Term Council Community Plan 2006/2016***

## **Amendment 1**

On page 171 of Council's LTCCP 2006/2016.

An amendment has been made to Council's viewpoint by the inclusion of an additional sentence as follows –

"Any decision by Council to divest itself of any of these buildings will require public consultation in terms of Section 83 of the Local Government Act 2002, as Community and Ward Halls are named as strategic assets in Council's Significance Policy."

## **Amendment 2**

Council's Revenue and Funding Policy in its 2006/2016 LTCCP states that separate rates will be raised District wide, as well as on a Ward basis, to fund the Land Transport Activity. In both cases these rates are based on Land Value.

As the Roading infrastructure is managed on a District wide basis, Council made an amendment to combine the Land Transport and Amenities rate into a general rate based on land values, determined by the number of kilometres of the Road network in each Ward.

The summary at the top of page 225 of the existing 2006/2016 LTCCP has been amended by removing reference to "Land Transport land value rates" and "Ward Amenities Land Value Rates" and replacing this with "A General Land Value Rate to fund Land Transport."
