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That Council will:

1. Observe and enforce requirements and provisions of the approved National Roothing Programme to the extent of Council's powers and authority and so far as its financial resources reasonably permit.
2. Carry out all its other statutory functions and responsibilities in the most cost effective and accountable manner.
3. Ensure that the road network is appropriate, that it is properly maintained, and where economic, is improved.
4. Endeavour to reduce vehicle operating and travel time costs.
5. Seek to reduce the number, severity and cost of traffic accidents.
6. Promote the development, continuation and improvement of the passenger transport services currently operating through and within the district.
7. Encourage greater local input into decision making in respect of all aspects of land transport.
8. Endeavour to provide and encourage alternate means of transport such as cycling and walking where appropriate.
9. Provide and maintain a safe and cost effective roading network that meets the economic and social needs of the people of the District.
10. Adhere to the Temporary Traffic Management for Local Roads Supplement to New Zealand Transport Agency's Code of Practice for Temporary Traffic Management as adopted.
11. Contribute where possible to the Government Policy Statements as they relate to land transport.
