- 1 Transpower New Zealand Limited ('**Transpower**') wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:
 - a an appeal by the New Zealand Agricultural Aviation Association ('Appellant') against part of the decision ('the Decision') of the Central Hawke's Bay District Council (the 'Respondent') on the proposed Central Hawke's Bay District Plan (the 'Proposed Plan') (Environment Court reference ENV-2023-AKL-000118).

2 Transpower:

- a has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the interest that the general public has. This is because Transpower, as the State-Owned Enterprise that plans, builds, maintains and operates New Zealand's National Grid, is a network utility operator with responsibility for a network utility (the National Grid).  - a A new rule for 'farm airstrips';
 - b Amendments sought to GRUZ-R5; and
 - c Amendments sought to PRROZ-R5.

- 8 Transpower agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.

New rule	Neither support nor oppose	The Appellant seeks to include a permitted activity rule in the GRUZ and RPROZ zones for 'farm airstrips'. Transpower is neutral as to the inclusion of the rule but seeks that a condition is included in the permitted activity rule that requires compliance with GRUZ-S13 (setbacks from National Grid).
GRUZ-R5	Oppose	The Appellant seeks that GRUZ-R5 be amended to not apply to facilities for agricultural aviation activities. Transpower considers that agricultural aviation activities need to comply with GRUZ-S13 (setbacks from the National Grid) in order to give effect to policies 10 and 11 of the NPSET.
RPROZ- R5	Oppose	The Appellant seeks that RPROZ-R5 be amended to not apply to facilities for agricultural aviation activities. Transpower considers that agricultural aviation activities need to comply with RPROZ-S15 (setbacks from the National Grid) in order to give effect to policies 10 and 11 of the NPSET.

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
