I oppose the appeal in its entirety, for the reasons set out below:

- Water storage in the Mākāroro Gorge is strongly opposed;
- It is incongruous to recognise the Mākāroro Gorge as an Outstanding Natural Feature
 with significant biodiversity values, and to then also promote water storage which will
 destroy that same ecosystem;
- Neither the "regional social and economic significance" of water storage within this catchment, nor the adverse environmental impact of water storage have been modelled or publicly explained. There is insufficient information upon which to support inclusion of this policy in the District Plan;
- The outcome sought by the appellant is inconsistent with Part 2 of the Resource Management Act 1991;
- The outcome sought by the appellant is inconsistent with the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020;
- Water storage for agricultural enterprises is a private sector concern for local agribusiness to address. It is not core Council business, nor a matter that should consume any more ratepayers' money or resources and which, in consequence, causes unnecessary division within the Central Hawkes Bay Community.

I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
