This is a further submission to various submissions on the Central Hawkes Bay Proposed District Plan on behalf of the Ministry of Education 'The Ministry'.

The specific parts of the further submission that the Ministry's submission relates to are submissions on provisions that either directly or indirectly have the potential to impact on the Ministry's interests and ability to achieve its purpose.

Background:

The Ministry is the Government's lead advisor on the New Zealand education system, shaping direction for education agencies and providers and contributing to the Government's goals for education. The Ministry assesses population changes, school roll fluctuations and other trends and challenges impacting on education provision at all levels of the education network to identify changing needs within the network so the Ministry can respond effectively.

The Ministry has responsibility not only for all State schools owned by the Crown, but also those State schools that are not owned by the Crown, such as designated character schools and State integrated schools. For the Crown owned State schools this involves managing the existing property portfolio, upgrading and improving the portfolio, purchasing and constructing new property to meet increased demand, identifying and disposing of surplus State school sector property and managing teacher and caretaker housing. The Ministry is therefore a considerable stakeholder in terms of how existing and future educational facilities and assets in the Central Hawkes Bay District are provided for.

Ministry involvement in the Proposed District Plan:

In April 2019, the Minister confirmed the existing designations to be rolled over with or without modification for inclusion in the Plan. Four designations were removed from the schedule and district plan maps. Following confirmation by the Minister, Notice of Requirement for Te Aute College has been issued and this school is included in the Minister's designations in the Plan.

In July 2019, the Ministry submitted on the Draft District Plan provisions in relation to the definition and provision for Education Facilities.

In August 2021, the Ministry submitted on the Proposed District Plan in relation to proposed definitions and provisions that either directly or indirectly have the potential to impact on the Ministry's interests and ability to achieve its purpose.
