



# Public notification of the Decisions on Central Hawke's Bay Proposed District Plan

Pursuant to Clauses 10 and 11 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, Central Hawke's Bay District Council gives notice that it has made a decision on provisions and matters raised in submissions on the Proposed District Plan.

## Inspection and availability of the decisions

The decision documents are available on Central Hawke's Bay District Council's website [www.chbdc.govt.nz/district-plan](http://www.chbdc.govt.nz/district-plan).

Copies of the decision can also be viewed at the Central Hawke's Bay District Council offices in Waipawa (28-32 Ruataniwha Street) and at all public libraries in the District.

Those persons who lodged submissions and further submissions will be directly served this public notice.

## Appeals to Environment Court

Any person who made a submission or further submission on the Central Hawke's Bay Proposed District Plan may appeal to the Environment Court in accordance with clause 14 of Schedule 1 of the RMA.

Any appeal must be in the prescribed form and lodged with the Environment Court and served on the Central Hawke's Bay District Council within 30 working days of service of this notice of decision (by 7 July 2023).

Furthermore, within 5 working days of lodging an appeal, you are required to serve a copy of your appeal on every person who made a submission on those provisions or matters to which your appeal relates. A list of submitters' addresses for service can be found on the Central Hawke's Bay District Council website.
