WAIPAWA POOL – PUBLIC MEETING

While preparing the Waipawa Pool for repainting for the 2017-18 season, significant cracks in the pool walls and floor have been uncovered. A large unbudgeted amount of work is required to get this prepared.

So Council is now in a quandary. Although committed to creating a long-term solution for the pool, they realise that continuing patch-ups at the pool is not a good use of rate-payer money.

“We do not want to continue a process for ‘band-aiding’ this significant asset. It deserves proper planning and investment so that further money spent

is on an outdoor facility that properly contributes to a thriving community.” says Mayor Walker.

“This may mean we are unable to open this season and as the only public outdoor pool in Central Hawke’s Bay this is incredibly frustrating.”

Special Licences

People requiring Special Licences for events or functions over the Christmas/New Year period are reminded to lodge their applications with Council before the end of November. This is to ensure that all the agencies involved have sufficient time to review applications, and for the application to be considered by the District Licencing Committee.

The issuing of any consents prior to Christmas will be reliant on the timeliness, completeness and accuracy of applications received.
