Pōrangahau Road Water Supply Upgrade

Kia ora,

Welcome to another monthly update - where we will update you on what's been happening on your street throughout November and December. Fulton Hogan are progressing well on site and are on track to meet the May 2023 target completion date

What's been happening over the last month?

New water mains have been fully installed from Lake View Road through to Gaisford Terrace, and new property connections are underway with hydrant installation. Traffic management has eased off, and you may have noticed less action, but rest assured the team are still working hard.

There have been some traffic management issues reported over the last month. We take these seriously and if you have any issues, please don't hesitate to talk to the contractors or myself. Again, we thank you for your patience while we install these new water mains.

What's happening over the next month?

Moving forward, you will see some notices in your mailbox regarding temporary water shutdowns. These are necessary shutdowns so Fulton Hogan can start connecting the new main into the existing network. Fulton Hogan will be sure to give you 72 hours' notice if your property will be affected.

Fulton Hogan will be closing the site over the Christmas break. All traffic management will be removed, and all potholes temporarily will be filled to ensure no issues or disruptions over this period. Fulton Hogan will be off site from 22 December until 16 January 2023.

FAQ's

What happens over the holiday period?

Fulton Hogan will be securing the site and leaving it tidy for the holiday period. Site works will cease on the 22nd of December 2022 and commence on the 16th of January 2023.

When will the project start and how long will it take?

The project started in July 2022 and will be completed by May 2023. We will update this information as the project progresses through flyers and on our website.

Will the area be left safe and tidy over the weekends and outside of work hours?

Yes, contractors will ensure all areas are left safe and tidy, with barriers around any excavations and residents informed of potential risks outside of working hours.

Will there be disruption to my water supply?

There will be minor disruptions while the water supply is changed over from the old supply to the new supply. We will communicate with affected residents in advance of any water supply shutdowns. If you are reliant on water, please do advise your key council contact. We expect to replace 22 laterals between Lake View Rd and Peterson Place, and 34 between Peterson Pl and Gaisford Terrace.

Will there be any traffic interruptions or diversions?

There will be traffic management in place to ensure the safety of residents and teams undertaking the work. We will work with Fulton Hogan to ensure residents are aware of the project and to keep these traffic interruptions to a minimum.

Will residents have any restrictions to access their homes?

There won't be any major restrictions, although there may be short periods of time when access to some driveways is limited. Individual property owners/tenants will be advised in advance.

Will there be a lot of noise?

There will be some noise because of vehicle movements and equipment operation. The impact of noise on the community will vary according to the time of day, nature of work and proximity to the noise source.

What are the hours of work on site?

The Fulton Hogan team are permitted to work on site from 7.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday. No work, other than emergency or maintenance work, will be undertaken on Sundays and Public Holidays without prior approval by Georgia Stone, Project Manager.
