The Takapau Lions Club give away approximately 18,000 - 23,000 dollars every year, so far beneficiaries in 2021 include Caring Families, the Takapau Christmas Lights and Santa House, Budget Advisory Service, Heart Kids, HB Rescue Helicopter Trust and Camp Quality to name a few.

They team up with the Waipawa Lions every year for the annual CHB Bookarama and this year 8,000 dollars raised went straight back into the community.

Members of the Takapau Lions Club split and deliver roughly 50 cords of firewood every year to those who need it most in the community.

Over the past 40 years the club has hosted Year 8 school tramping trips to the top of Tiraha in the Ruahine Ranges. They have also maintained the Daphne Hut at the bottom of Daphne Spur, giving the hut the TLC it needs to accommodate trampers in the Ruahine Forrest.

The Takapau Lions Club also volunteer their time to help maintain The Tukituki Trail.
