



What's happening on Great North Road?



We're pleased to report Higgins have completed the water main upgrade on Great North Road between Tamumu Road and Abbotsford Road.

The team have been replacing around 215m of aged and undersized pipe to improve the reliability and resilience of the drinking water network serving the northern Waipawa area.

We thank all road users and our community for their understanding and patience with the traffic delays and disruption as we improve this critical asset for our community.

The team have also installed the new wastewater pipe from Tamumu Road to Abbotsford Road. Work is now underway to extend the wastewater network further north. From 19 June - 23 June 2023 and 26 June - 27 June 2023, between 7.30am - 4.30pm road users will not be able to enter or exit Abbotsford Road from SH2 so Higgins can safely extend the wastewater pipe.

Traffic management will be in place and vehicles entering or exiting Abbotsford Road from SH2 will be detoured through Waverley Road, Church Street and Domain Road. Vehicles will still be able to enter and exit Abbotsford Road via this route.
