Waipawa's main street safety improvements continue

Safety improvements to the High Street in Waipawa are well underway with the first phase to upgrade the stormwater network near the Cenotaph nearly complete.

The second phase is scheduled to kick off next week with construction of the raised crossings and a one-lane detour in place until 7 October 2023.

We encourage our community to continue to support local and explore the wonderful retail options available. Parking will be available on the main street and additional parking is also available on Kenilworth Street as well as Islington Drive.

Please remember to be kind to our road workers. The Waipawa community have been advocating for many years for speed reduction and safety improvements, including a community petition in 2020 and a community campaign, which remains in place, reminding people to slow down. This project along with Streets for People will help to improve safety and slow traffic down to create a more accessible. people friendly township for Waipawa with international research showing a reduction in death and serious injury by around 40 percent.

Work remains on schedule with works expected to be complete 15 October. Thanks for your patience and support.
