Many homes in the district will have a water meter which are read four times a year.

You will only receive an invoice from our Waters team when you exceed the annual water allocation of 300 m³. If you receive an unexpected water invoice from us, it could be an indication you have a leak on your property. If this is the case, get the leak repaired promptly and contact our Finance team 06 857 8060 and we can investigate whether the invoice can be reversed. This is an important way we can monitor water conservation and ensure leaks are repaired quickly.
