



Level 2 water restrictions

A reminder that Level 2 water restrictions remain in place across Central Hawke's Bay.

This means outdoor watering can take place on alternate days, at limited times only. Even numbered houses on even days of the month. For example, if you live at number 10, you may use a sprinkler or hose on the 2nd, 4th, 6th and so on. Odd numbered houses are on odd days of the month. For example, if you live at number 11, you may use a sprinkler or hose on the 1st, 3rd and 5th of the month and so on.

Sprinklers can be used for one hour per day only, before 9am and after 5pm. Hand held hoses can be used before 10am and after 4pm but cannot be left running unattended. Hosing of hard surfaces is not allowed as part of general cleaning. Let's work together to ensure there's enough water for everyone!


**HB Jazz Club Big Band
