

Waipukurau Water Firefighting and Shortfalls Improvements

From approx. **Monday 29th July 2019** works are planned to commence on this project to improve firefighting capacity, shortfalls in supply and resilience of the Waipukurau water network.

The project is broken into 3 stages, with stages 1 and 2 underway from late July 2019 to Dec 2019.

- **Stage 1:** Hunter Park to South Service Lane
- **Stage 2:** South Service Lane to Northumberland Street
- **Stage 3:** Northumberland Street to Peel Street

The works along Ruataniwha Street, and affecting businesses are planned to be undertaken at night, further communication will be provided to all affected parties closer to the time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

What is the reason for this work?

This project will see the first 2 of a 7 stage upgrade to the water network to better address security of supply, resolve issue areas of fire flow compliance, allow for future connections within the urban boundary and service planned future growth.

When will the project start and how long will it take?

We expect Stages 1 then 2 to start in July 2019 and be completed by December 2019. Stage 3 is planned to start in July 2020.

Will there be disruption to my water supply?

There will be minor disruptions as the water supply is changed over from the old supply to the new supply, this will be communicated to affected parties in advance of water supply shut downs. If you are reliant on water – do advise us in advance through the contact details below.

Will there be any traffic interruptions or diversions?

Council will work with contractors to ensure residents are aware of the project and to keep traffic interruptions to a minimum.

Will residents have any restrictions to access their homes?

There may be short periods of time when access to driveways is limited. Individual property owners/tenants will be advised in advance.

Will parking spaces be affected?

There may be parking spaces cordoned off for short periods of time, works are being planned to minimise disruption, and the effect on the community.

Will there be a lot of noise?

There will be some noise because of vehicle movements, and operation of equipment. The impact of noise will vary according to the time of day, nature of work and proximity to the noise source. Any concerns/ complaints – please contact the team below.
