A Word from the Mayor

This year's Anzac Day marks 108 years since the first Anzac Services were held on 25 April 1916.

Anzac Day is a time to reflect on the thousands of lives cut short by war and conflict and the terrible cost paid by families, communities and our nation.

On 25 April 1915, the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC) landed at Gallipoli in Turkey, the site of New Zealand's first major battle of World War 1 which saw the loss of over 2,700 New Zealand soldiers.

This year, Dawn Services will take place in Waipukurau, Otāne and Pōrangahau at 5.45am. Hatuma, Ongaonga, Tikokino, Omakere and Elsthorpe Anzac Services will commence at 9 am, followed by Takapau at 10 am and Waipawa at 11 am.

On 25 April it is important that we remember the bravery and honour of all our servicemen and servicewomen.

We will remember them.
