Update for neighbours

Thanks to Government investment announced this week, a long-held local vision for new homes in the heart of Central Hawke's Bay will become reality.

For years we've shared the community's frustration that prime residential land on the old hospital site has sat empty while housing is so scarce.

This week the Government announced that Central Hawke's Bay District Council will receive \$10.9 million from the Infrastructure Acceleration Fund for crucial work including transport improvements, kilometres of new pipeline for wastewater and water supply, a new water reservoir, and major stormwater upgrades.

This funding will enable up to 950 homes to be built on the 50 hectares also known as the Waipukurau South Growth Precinct and will support a range of dwelling types from retirement housing to larger blocks open to the market, and smaller homes.

The area has been zoned residential for more than twenty years.
